1. Search for “OverDrive” in your smartphone’s or tablet’s app store.



2. Install the OverDrive app.



*** Overdrive is the same software used by the San Antonio Public Library to circulate their digital collection.**



*** Overdrive will allow you to save digital books to your device. When you do this, you will not need an Internet connection to read the books.**

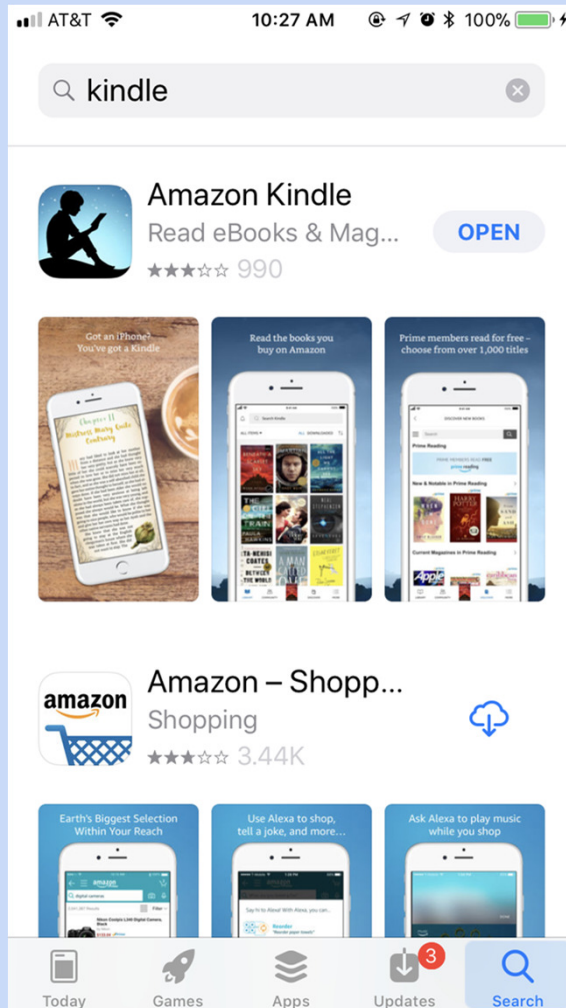

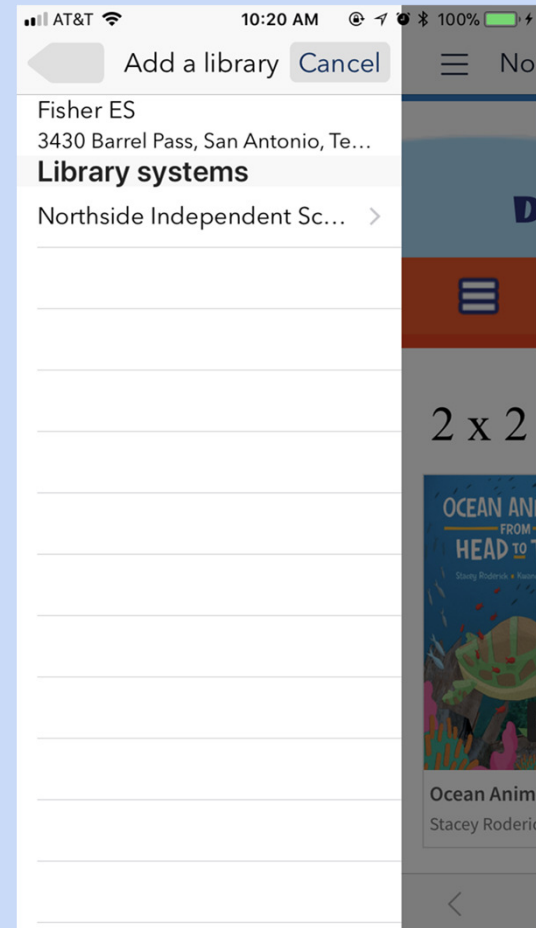
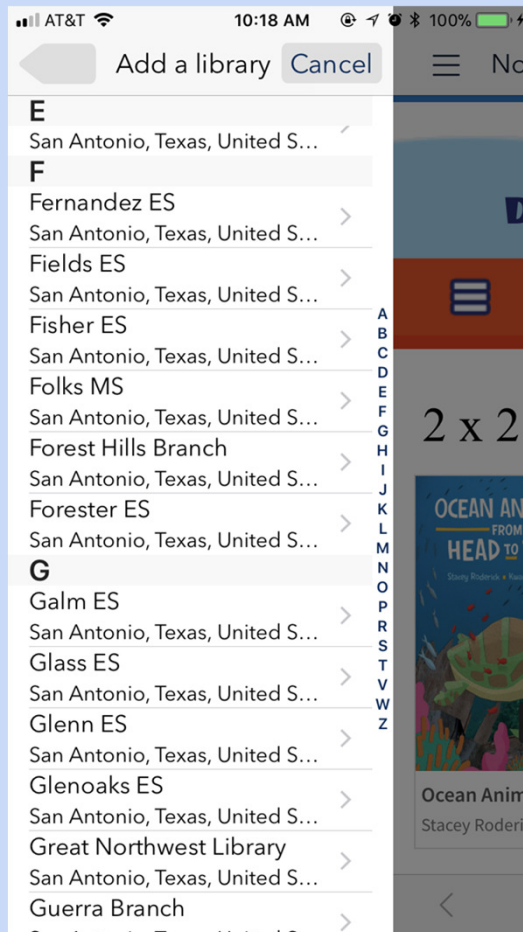
5. In “My Libraries” click “Add a library” to find your school.




6. Search for your school by zip code.



7. Scroll down and click on Fisher, then click on Northside.



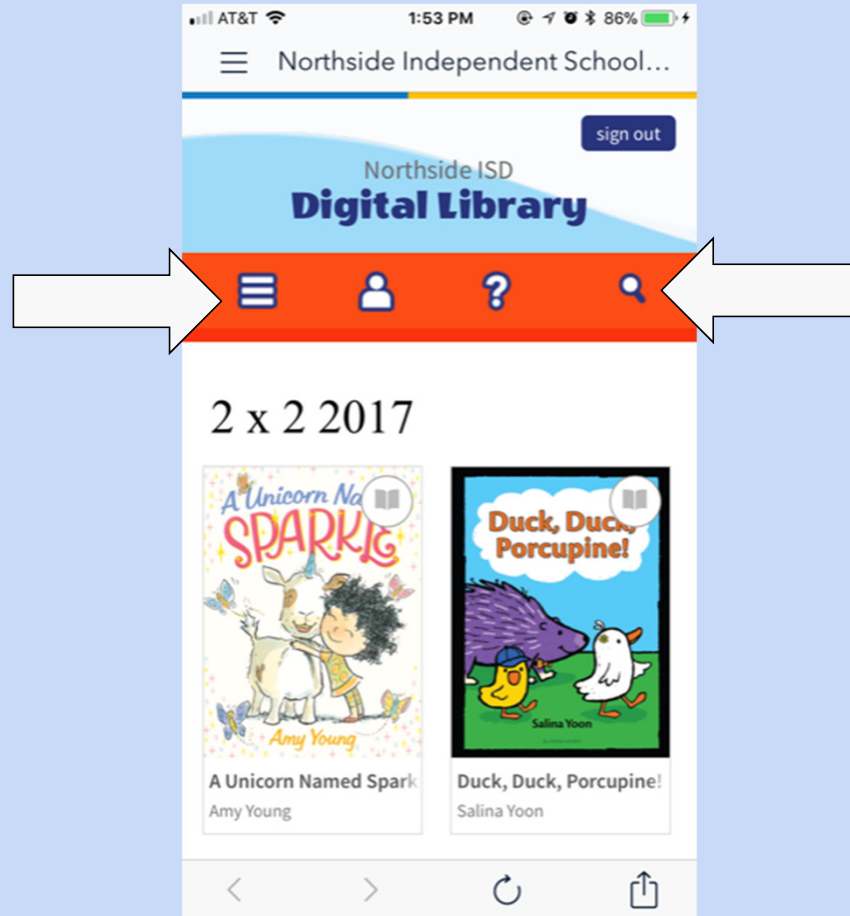
8. Log into the digital library site with your child's username. This will be their student ID# with an "s" in front of it.

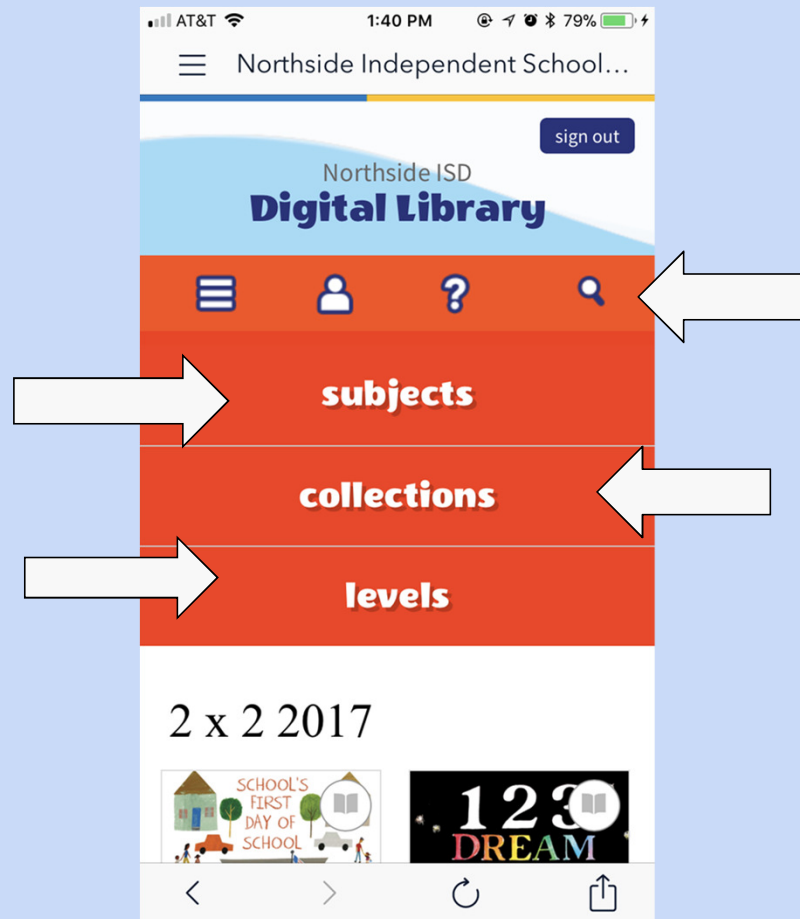
9a. Browse titles or search for a book about a topic in which you are interested. There are several main ways to browse.

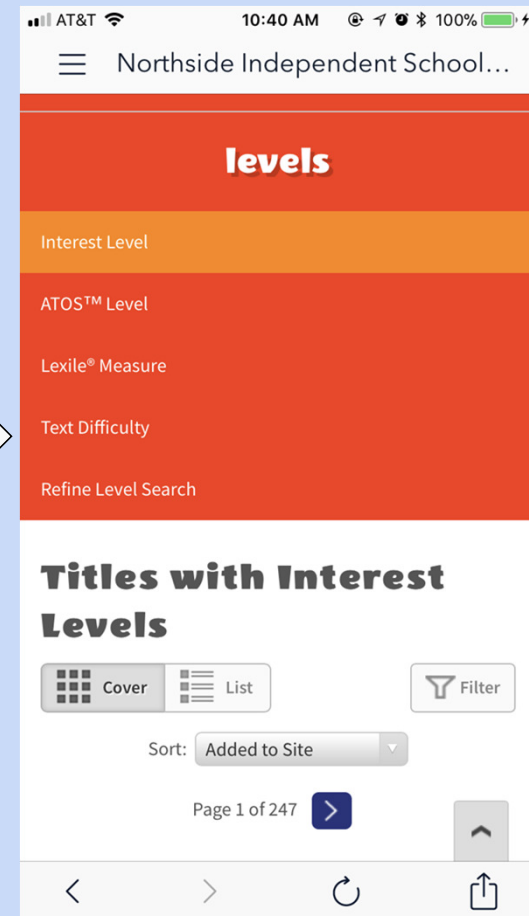
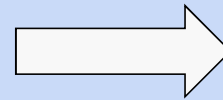
9b. These are the 4 main ways to browse.



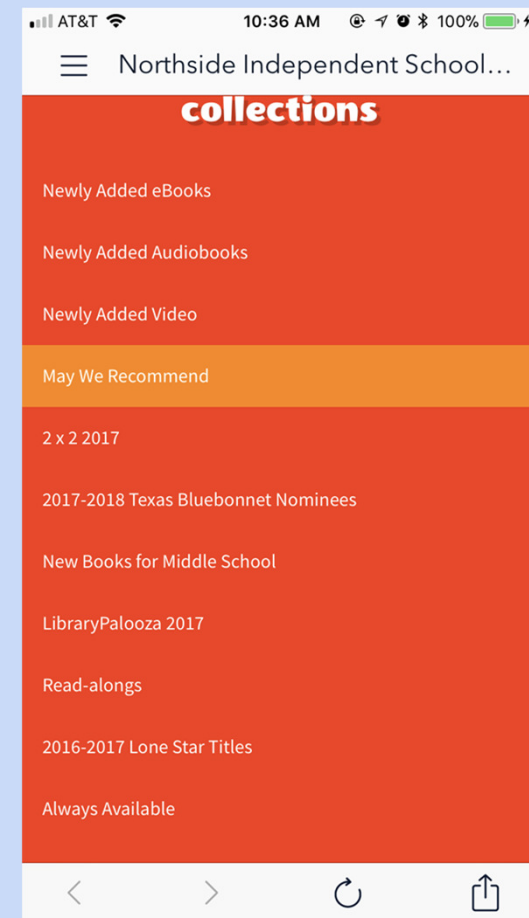
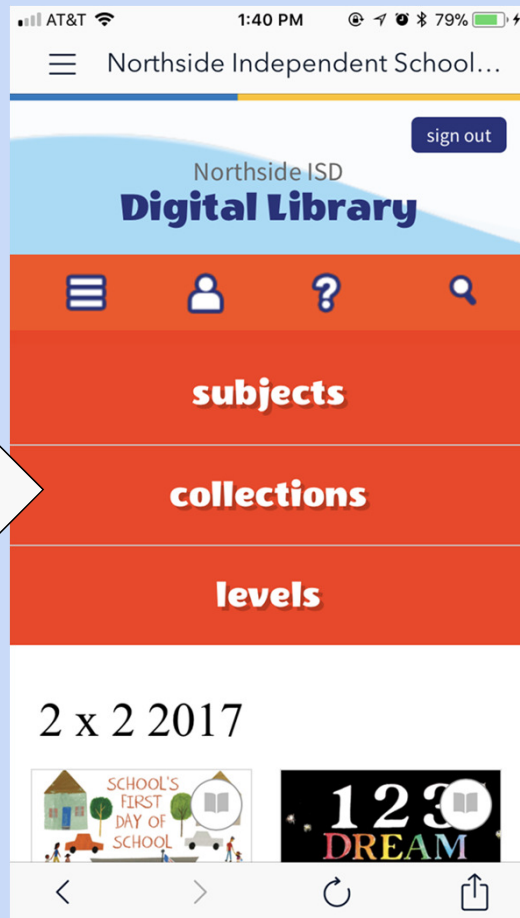
9c. If you click on “subject” you will get a list of all the subjects in the NISD collection.



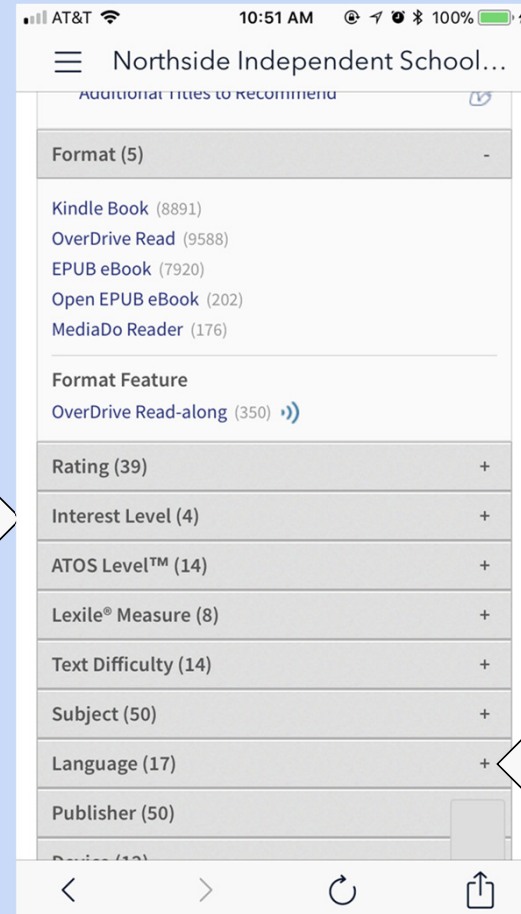
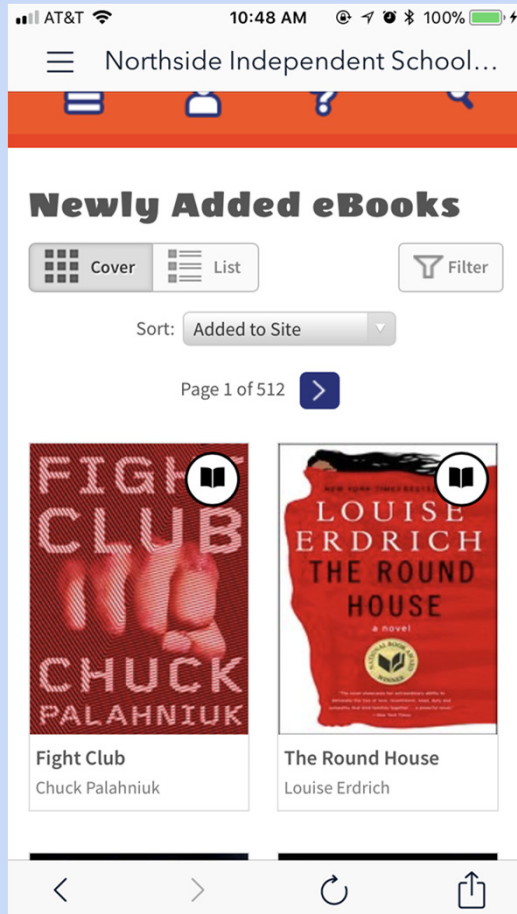
9d. If you click on “levels” you can browse by reading level or interest level.



9e. If you click on “collections” you will see categories such as “2x2 books”, “Bluebonnet books”, and “Newly Added eBooks”.

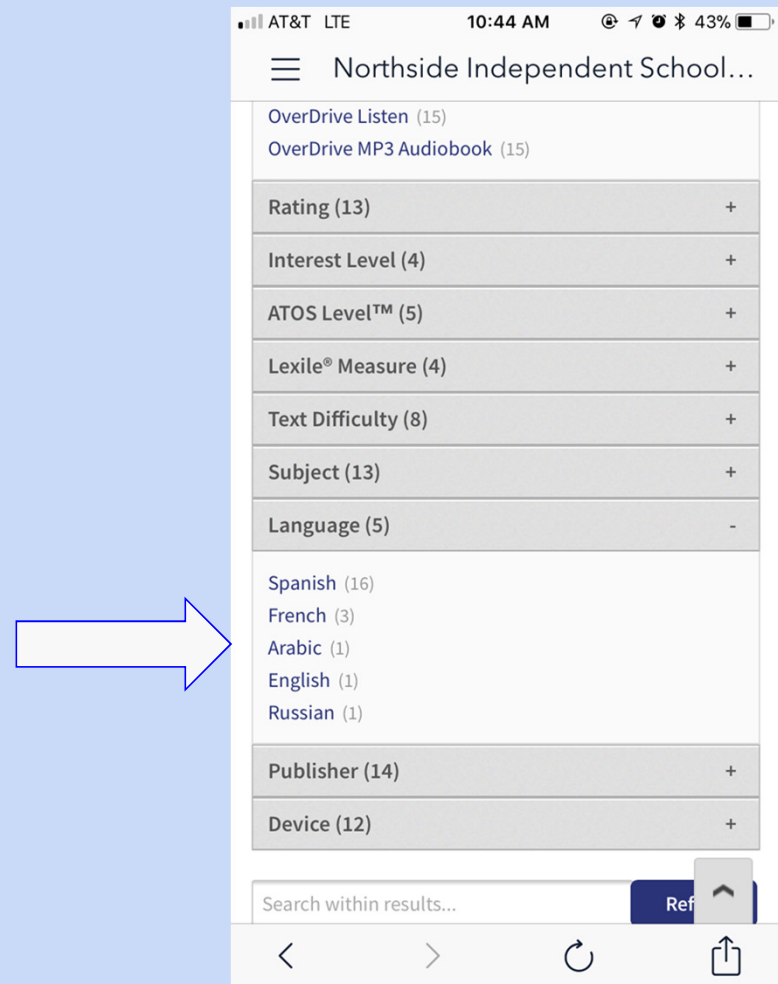
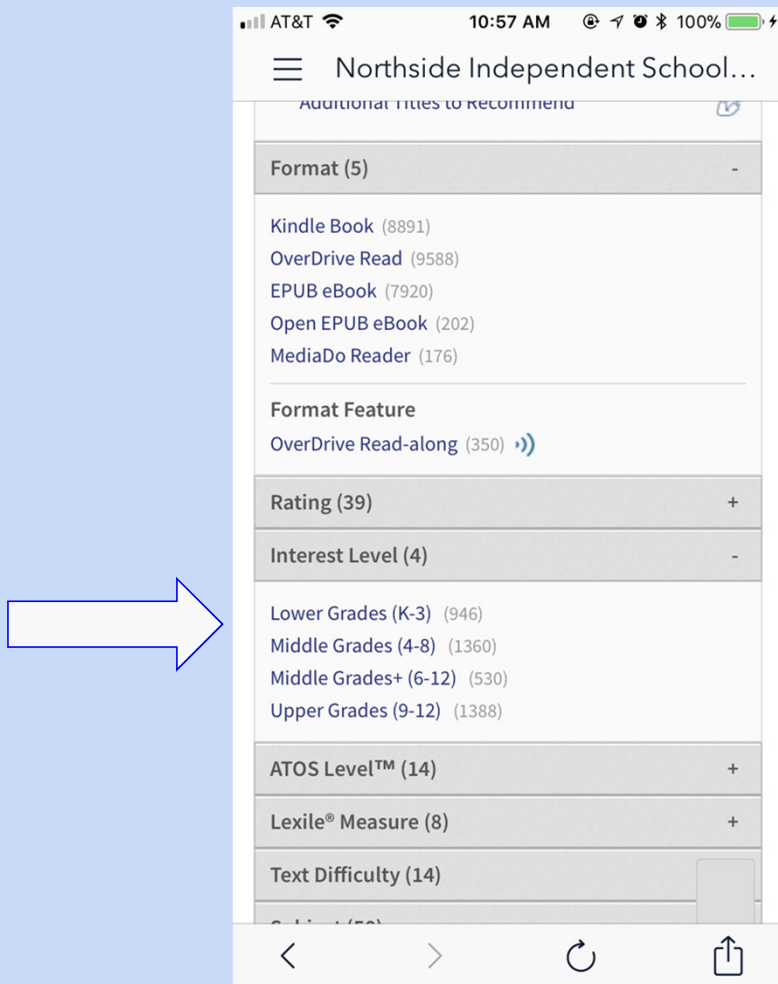


10a. Click the Filter button to narrow your search.

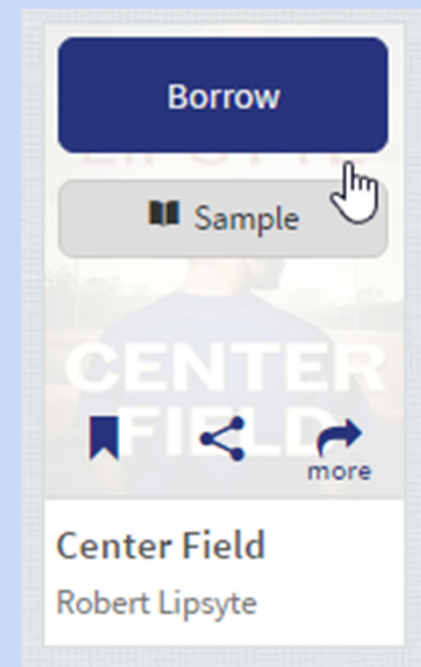
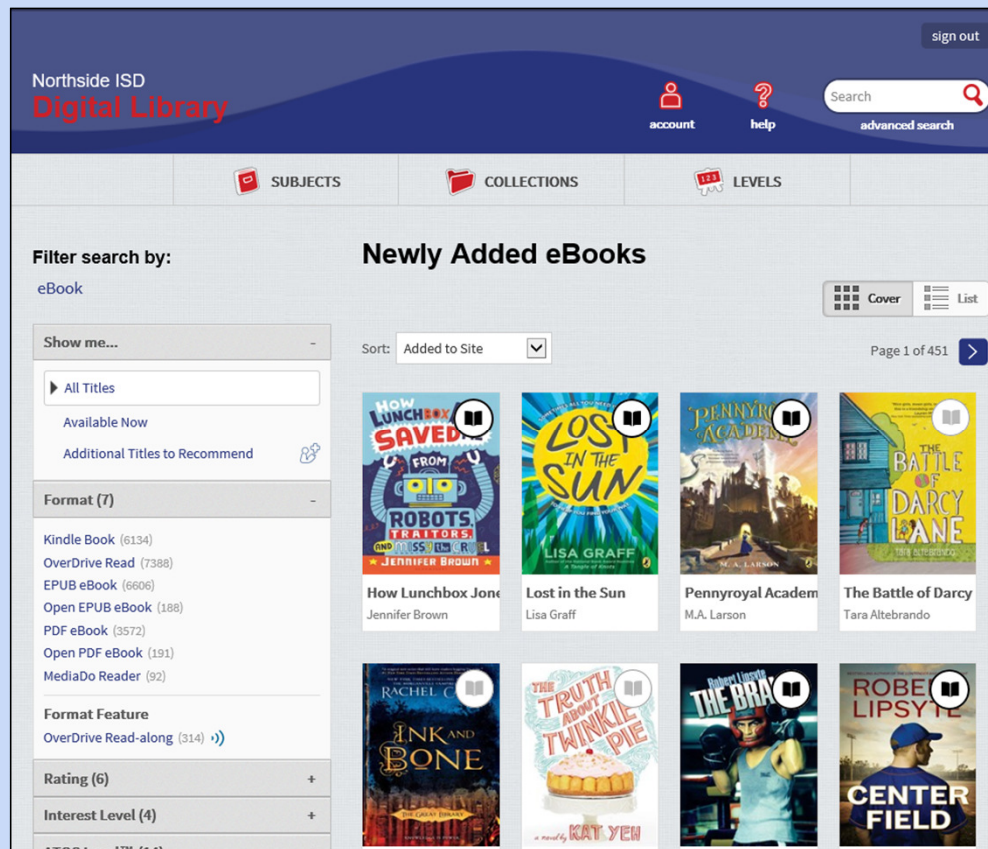


You can search by language if you want to look for books in other languages.

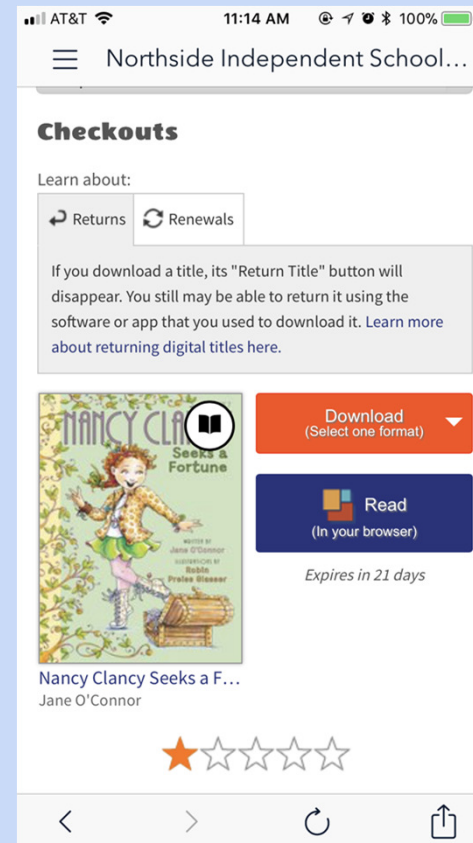
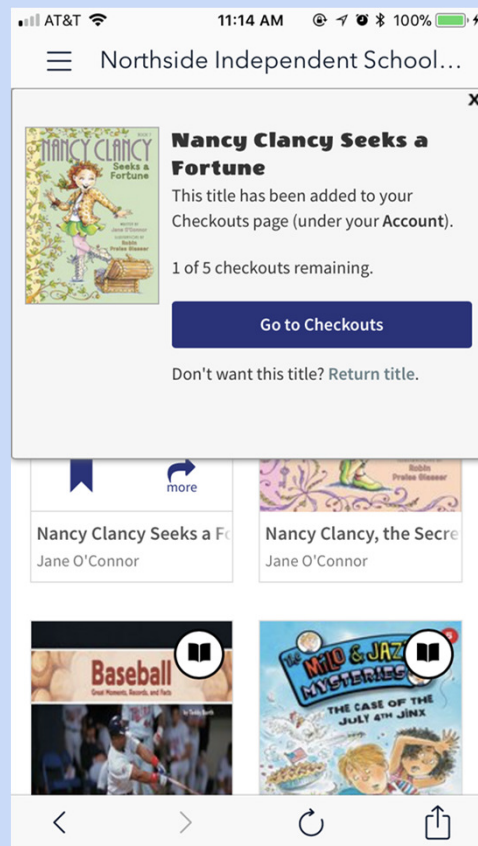
10b. Click the Filter button to narrow your search.

1. Go to www.nisd.net
2. Hover over **Departments**, then click on **Library Services**.
3. Hover over **Educators/Students**, then click on **Elementary Library Resources**.
4. Scroll down to the 3rd section, called **E-books**.
5. Click on **Overdrive**.
